




# **MODERN EXTERIOR**


### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:






# **MODERN INTERIOR**



# **TRADITIONAL EXTERIOR**


### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:





# **CRAFTSMAN EXTERIOR**


### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

- Tapered columns
- Low-pitched roof lines, gables, deeply overhanging eaves
- Partially paneled doors

Craftsman home exteriors are known for their distinct "arts and crafts" style. This often is reflected in features such as patterned window panes, covered porches, and earthy, neutral paint colors. One particular trademark of this style are the style of door they use. Most Craftsman homes feature doors with glass panes in the upper third of the door, separated from the bottom paneled portion from a thick piece of trim.



# **CRAFTSMAN INTERIOR**

Craftsman interiors reflect many of the characteristics seen on their exterior, particularly in the doors. Most craftsman style doors feature paned glass and sidelights are also common. Built-in cabinetry is a regular fixture in Craftsman style homes, as is stained wood. These homes tend to showcase large fireplaces and exposed wooden beams. A celebration of more natural looking wood is common, with lots of wooden window frames and thick wooden baseboards or crown molding.



# **TRANSITIONAL EXTERIOR**


### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:





# **COTTAGE EXTERIOR**


### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:

Cottage exteriors are known for their charming appearance and smaller footprint. It's fairly common for them to feature an asymmetrical facade, where the focus is placed on the front door. These doors often feature raised panels and curved lines to add to the home's curb appeal. Much attention is paid to the window shapes, arched doors, and trim of a Cottage style home. It's also common to see a prominent chimney in a Cottage.



# **COTTAGE INTERIOR**

The interior space of a Cottage is marked by the casual, informal feel of the space. Many times hallways are eliminated from a cottage, to encourage a smooth transition from one room to the next. 

# **RUSTIC EXTERIOR**


### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:






# **RUSTIC INTERIOR**
